Land Acknowledgement

Northfield United Methodist Church and its property stand on the homelands of the Wahpekute and Mkwakanton bands of the Dakota Nation. We know that the earlies days of our congregation were contemporaneous with John North establishing the town boundaries on land recently ceded by the Dakota in an 1851 treaty, and that after the US-Dakota War of 1862, the state of Minnesota forcibly exiled the remaining Dakota people from this area.

We confess that the story-telling done by the Northfield United Methodist Church has contributed to the erasure and dehumanization of the Dakota people. It is up to each of us to repair the damages of settler colonialism by sharing accurate histories, building and sustaining meaningful relationships with our Dakota neighbors, and working toward authentic healing.
